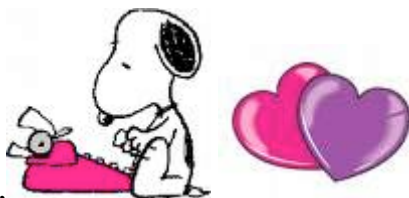

**God Loves Me and My Family!**



Here's a great art project or card that your students can make for caregivers during the loving month of February!

-Younger students can color and decorate the pieces directly on the template, later cut and layer/assemble. Note: circles with face features have been provided in the template, but also blank circles have been provided so older children can make the face features.

-Fold another piece of paper or construction paper in half and glue/layer pieces on the front.

Or

-Print the template and cut out the pieces. Then use the patterns to trace onto construction paper, colored paper, scraps of wrapping paper, or scraps of fabric. You can make additional children to glue in front of the Mom or Dad large template.

-Art project instead of cards: Instead of folding the paper to form a card, make a small poster to accommodate the additional children templates, and glue onto another larger colored piece of paper to make a pretty frame. Add the phrase:

**God Loves Me and My Family!**

Read the suggestions below for different age groups:



#### **Children 18 months to 3 years:**

The youngest child can participate in this greeting card creation. Add a few drops of glue (or use glue stick) to a folded piece of paper (or card stock) and child can place the pieces on the front of the card. You can add a handprint cut-out or paint the child's handprint to the inside of the card and write a message on top.

#### **Children 3+ and older:**

Older children can add and decorate the plain colored pieces first with glitter, paint: brush strokes, sponging, cotton ball dabbing, stampers, cut-up tissue paper, and scraps

of fabric to make collage or a patchwork effect, etc., and then proceed to cut out the pieces and layer the pieces as suggested in the small image on the template.



### Create a 3-D Effect:

Place little pieces of rolled up tape instead of glue behind the pieces. This raises the different layers just a bit, and gives a nice 3-D effect.
